Bordeaux Wine – Grand Puy Lacoste x Haut Batailley Master Class

Chateau Grand-Puy-Lacoste not only distinguishes itself as a classic wine of Pauillac, it also impresses in outperforming its original Fifth Growth classification back in 1855. Grand-Puy-Lacoste is located a couple of kilometres west of the town of Pauillac, not far from Lynch-Bages.

The 55 hectares of vines are planted to 75% Cabernet Sauvignon and 25% Merlot. They are in one block and surround the 19th Century chateau and other buildings. The oldest vines are some 40 years. Apart from vines, there's also a park.

Mr. Francois-Xavier Borie (proprietor also of other Pauillac Fifth Growth Chateau Haut-Batailley) had originally been managing Ducru-Beaucaillou together with their father Jean-Eugene Borie. Part of that credit must go to the consultants engaged by the estate. Although he has departed from Chateau Ducru-Beaucaillou, Francois-Xavier BORIE continues to tap the expertise of the same consultants as when he was at the Saint-Julien property.
